Common Saints' Attributes

- Objects
 - Book and sword St. Paul
 - Candle St. Genevieve
 - Cleaver St. Peter Martyr
 - Golden balls St. Nicholas of Bari
 - Keys St. Peter
 - Music St. Cecilia
 - Pot St. Mary Magdalene
 - Veil St. Veronica
 - Wheel St. Catherine of Alexandria
- Animals
 - Dragon St. George
 - Eagle St. John the Evangelist
 - Lamb St. John the Baptist ("Behold the Lamb of God" John 1:36)
 - Lion St. Jerome
- Body Parts
 - Beard St. Wilgefortis
 - Breasts St. Agatha
 - Eyes St. Lucy
 - Flayed skin St. Bartholomew the Apostle
 - Stigmata St. Francis of Assissi
 - Tooth and pincers St. Apollonia

How to Identify Saints in Artworks

- Identify as many objects or images that appear around or on the saint as you can (attributes).
 - a. Think of synonyms for the names of these objects eg. hound = dog = canine
 - b. Pay attention to animals, flowers, unusual objects such as body parts or objects of torture, etc.
- 2. Look up these objects in Iconclass Online.
- 3. If you are looking at multiple pieces of art, make notes of attributes or names that appear over and over.
- 4. Look these repeated themes/objects/names up in a general art iconography book or online resource to find the biography of your saint.
- 5. For even more information, look your saint up in a book or online resource of Christian iconography.
